Purpose


We are a member-based organisation that challenges and advocates for change on behalf of our members to make Perth consistently one of the most liveable cities in the world.

Why is 2050 important?


We have always spoken about being future focused and this future time frame is big enough to be real and have significant impact.



In 2050 Perth and Peel is expected to be 3.5 million population.











Perth is in a geographically strategic location, close to Indonesia, Singapore, Japan, China and South Korea.
